come, Sendeth Greeting, Whereas Nathias Baker and Mary his Wife by Indenture under their hands & Seals and for the consideration and under the Reservations and ground rents therein mentioned and Reserved, bearing date the twenty second Day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty five, did grant bargain sell convey & confirm unto the aforesaid George Myrise Farmer of Germany Township and County of York and to his Heirs and Assigns forever, the following piece parcel or two Lots of ground in the Town of Petersburg lying and being Situate on the South side of the Main Street called Kings Street Bounded on the North by the Street aforesaid on the East by a Lot of ground of Nicholas Onstade on the South by a twenty feet alley & on the West by a fifteen feet alley and known on the general plan of the said Town by the Numbers seventy five and seventy six containing in front on the Street aforesaid forty six feet and in length or depth two hundred and sixty four feet &c as in & by the Deed aforesaid Recorded &c will fully appear. Now know Ye that I the aforesaid George Myrise for and in consideration of the Sum of seventeen pounds in gold or silver now Lawfull money of Pennsylvania to me
